On March 4, 2020, The United States Department of Education Office of Postsecondary Education released “[Guidance for Interruptions of Study Related to Coronavirus \(COVID-19\)](#).”

ACCJC is here to support our member institutions in navigating the impacts of this outbreak on your student populations. Many colleges are imposing closures or self-quarantines and moving from face-to-face instruction to online or out-of-class work options. Per the newly released Department of Education guidelines, ACCJC will help facilitate any changes you make to accommodate cancellations and closures with expanded online or correspondence classes this semester.

We are waiving review and technology requirements for distance learning and correspondence education at institutions affected by the COVID-19 outbreak. Distance education instructors must maintain regular, substantive communication with students; specifics about these communications can be found in the Office of Postsecondary Education’s release.
