On behalf of the Nominating Committee, the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges (ACCJC) is seeking nominations and applications from individuals who wish to be considered for election as Commissioners to ACCJC.

Commissioners are elected for a three-year term, and are eligible for re-election for a second three-year term. The composition of the Commission membership can be found in the ACCJC Bylaws, Article III, Section 1; the process for electing Commissioners can also be found in the ACCJC Bylaws. Nominations may be sent via a letter that names the nominee and includes his or her contact information. It should be signed and dated by the person making the nomination. The nomination letter may serve as one of the nominee's required letters of recommendation. Nomination letters should be sent to Alexandra Spring at [communications@accjc.org](mailto:communications@accjc.org). Please note that all nominees must complete the Commissioner Application Form and upload the required supporting documents. Persons may also self-nominate by completing the Commissioner Application Form and uploading the required documents. Within the online application form, nominees/applicants will submit the following:

- a. A letter of application stating the basis for interest in service on the Commission
- b. A resume
- c. Two letters of recommendation

All nomination letters, Commissioner Application Forms, and supporting documents must be **submitted no later than 3:00 p.m. on May 21, 2021**, to receive consideration as per the ACCJC Bylaws. [CLICK HERE to access the application](#).
